

1. Open up the internet browser Google Chrome (or another preferred browser of your choice).



2. In the address bar type in <u>careerbuilder.com</u> (or another job search engine) and hit enter.



3. Once on the website, type in the job that you want in the "job titles, skills, or company" bar.



4. Next, search the city or desired location in the bar to the right (you may also do a job search by location only if you are not sure what you want to do).



5. Click the "find jobs" button when all information entered.
